(San Francisco) – The Mission Neighborhood Health Center (MNHC) announces that the Adelante! Youth Program is receiving applications for its 2021-2022 cohort. The Adelante! Youth Leaders Advancing Health Equity trains San Francisco high school students interested in becoming health educators. The training program supports youth through personal development and community engagement.
